**A:** No. Each A.A. entity — group, district, area, and G.S.O. — provides a specific service and is autonomous. Each is separate from the other.

**A:** Your contributions pay for:

- The printing of meeting lists & group flyers when requested
- Maintaining the district Web site
- The telephone answering service, including the phone bill and contributions to Central Office to help defray costs
- Purchasing back issues of the Grapevine for treatment and recovery centers within the district
- Registration fees, rooms and meals for any interested member to attend AA functions outside the district.
- New group starter kits

**Q: Are district officers/coordinators paid?**

**A:** No.

**Q: Who decides what to do with district funds?**

**A:** The GSRs by attending District Meetings

**Q: What does Area 60 do with our contribution?**

**A:** Provides the funding of Area Assemblies, workshops, the Area 60 Web site, funds for the Area delegate and others to attend AA service conferences, and many other direct support services.

**Q: Is our group responsible for contributing to Intergroups, other entities or AA groups?**

**A:** No. District 14 groups do not receive any direct support from any other entities.
