A: There is no longer a prescribed percentage to any of the 3 levels of contributions District 14 Groups should be making:

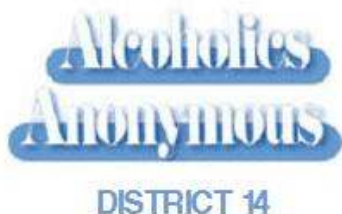

A: Your contributions pay for:

- The printing of meeting lists & group flyers when requested
- Maintaining the district Web site
- The telephone answering service.
- Purchasing back issues of the Grapevine for treatment and recovery centers within the district
- Registration fees for Area functions outside the district

Q: Are district officers/coordinators paid?

A: No.

Q: Who decides what to do with district funds?

A: The GSRs by attending District Meetings

Q: What does Area 60 do with our contribution?

A: Provides the funding of Area Assemblies, workshops, the Area 60 Web site, funds for the Area delegate and others to attend AA service conferences, and many other direct support services.

Q: Is our group responsible for contributing to Intergroups, Central Office in Pittsburgh or other offices or AA groups?

A: No. District 14 groups do not receive any direct support from any other offices.
