### **OUR GOAL:**

1. To help individuals and AA groups understand how they can be self-supporting in maintaining their literature inventory.
2. To help individuals and AA groups order and supply their own literature, locally.

### **INDIVIDUAL ORDERS:**

You, as an AA member can order literature from your own district.

Simply complete an order form and mail it to the district literature coordinator (address on other side). Your order will be filled and available for pick up at the next district meeting (the first Wednesday of each month). All orders must be placed by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month to be available for pick-up at the next monthly district meeting. ### **FOR GROUP ORDERS:**

The group conscience should be considered prior to ordering group literature to determine the needs of the members.

The group GSR or literature coordinator can either mail in or bring a completed order form to the district meeting. Payment is required at time of order. All sales are payable by checks and made payable to District 14. Orders will be filled from the district inventory and/or ordered as necessary. All orders must be placed by the 10<sup>th</sup> of the month to be available for pick-up at the next monthly district meeting.
